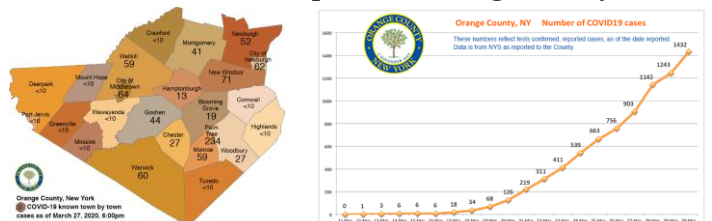

《纽约橙郡华人协会近期抗疫举措》 by 史秀全

随着美国疫情迅猛的发展，纽约州的纽约市成为新冠肺炎“风暴眼”。巨大的压力从医疗机构到普通民众弥散开来。虽偏隅纽约北郊，但是橙郡在整个纽约州的疫情队列里面还是有名次的。一些市镇也有通往纽约市的通勤火车和公共汽车，特别是还有北美地区最大的购物中心-Woodbury 奥特莱斯名品折扣店，也还有特殊族群集中居住的地区，以上因素，都对疫情的发生发展有影响。

前一阵子协会广泛发动并组织会员捐款购买防护用品寄送到武汉，针对性与时效性也很不错。协会会员也跟随国内疫情的平缓而心情有所放松，可是，随着欧洲国家的病例增多和美国疫情的变化，这种短暂的放松和安静又被打破了。汹涌的疫情如乌云压境，伴随各个层次的新闻发布会，雷声大，雨点也大，瞬间就到了眼前。各位会员家庭纷纷购置防护用品和储存适量的蔬菜与粮食，紧张而有序。但是个人消毒防护用品的缺货却是真实的。橙郡华人协会也积极发动各个会员及其所在工作单位，尽量筹集有关防护用品。第一批 100 余瓶免洗洗手液由会员集中购置并在 3 月 15 日，分三个地点按照提前的接龙登记，平价分发到需要的会员手中，当然，前后义工的身影在冷风中等待各家到来的印象十分深刻。

按照国内最基本的要求，呼吸道疾病的防护自然要出入戴口罩。美国医疗机构和市场上，口罩缺货严重。严重到个人都在或多或少接受国内亲戚朋友的邮寄赠送，医疗机构把本来一次性使用的外科口罩要多次利用，不科学但眼下没有更多的办法。协会集体力量再次体现，先是从各个群组或其他协会发帖联系到一批 KN95 口罩，在力求募集资金的前提下，迅速安排会员购得，并根据协会在当地医疗第一线的会员需要给与第一时间的捐赠，也是对美国目前医疗防护资源短缺的一点贡献。

经过约两周的等待，疫情日益严重，协会预定的个人防护口罩终于批量到来，3 月 28 日上午，经过协商，为了符合社交距离的要求，橙郡华人教会在新址配合协会分发预定的口罩。上午天气不好，阴沉沉，但志愿者们早早抵达，疏导车流，安排交接程序，事前与事后消毒都做到位。整个过程严谨，有序。橙郡华人协会在这次的疫情中，扎实的做着力所能及的工作。

“勿以善小而不为”。今天下午我和夫人去当地警察局捐了些 N95 口罩，大约 50 多个吧。本来是美国疫前买来准备寄给国内父母姐妹的。现在国内静下来，美国爆发了。眼下全美包括医院，警察，ambulance 等机构均出现防疫装备/口罩短缺。疫情快速蔓延用量剧增是原因，更重要的是我们华人支持国内武汉抗疫几乎扫光了美国市场的口罩。有统计显示华人在美国大约捐赠给国内 2.5 亿个口罩。现在美国疫情严峻，同一批美国华人又掀起了爱心运动，为美国抗疫捐款。刚刚跟踪了美国华人的爱心捐款，一看吓了一跳，华人爱心基金会捐款已达到了 50 万，几个大公司以 1:1 匹配，就是说华人个人捐款已 25 万多。这还没算很多社区和不同协会的捐款。说起捐钱买口罩感触颇多。

前段给国内捐，是爱同胞之心，没有条件的捐。眼下为美国捐也是爱心捐，但同时有点内疚赎罪的感觉。现在美国抗疫紧急戴口罩防护服，谁都知道是什么原因，可是我们华人谁

听到了美国政府，媒体或是个人抱怨了？还有，第二次捐款买口罩还很难不容易。美国自己不生产口罩，从国外进口现在也不太顺利。到有头脑灵活的商人从.....弄到美国一些口罩，现在像炒房地产一样，翻了倍的卖，\$0.85 一个，现在已经卖到了\$7.00 一个。急用没有办法，政府要花高价买，我们捐的钱买口罩恐怕也要花这个价了。据说，国难时期美国可以控制自己的物价，但对外来产品价格没办法。这很令人气愤。昨天我爱人外出回来看见路上巡逻的警察检查车辆时都没有戴口罩，他们也确实没有，市面上没有卖的。有报道，有很多警察工作中不幸感染了。电视上不断播出缺少医用口罩，还有教人们怎样自己做防疫口罩。我们看着都为现在不得不在外面工作的人担心。今天下午，我和夫人去了警察局。这次不是去办事，是捐几只口罩，没留名字，留下华人的一个身影，留下华人热爱社区的一点善意。

一点感悟：清晨当我开着车刚刚拐进 Goshen 新教会场地的時候，一眼就看到了施家三兄弟 Josh, James 和 Jesse 在满是湿泥的草地上来回地奔跑穿梭，热心地帮助着协会有条不紊地指挥着前来领取口罩的繁忙车流，我的眼眶顿时湿润了！他们三个都是需要更多睡眠的年轻孩子啊！Joseph 带领着自己的孩子们冒着被病毒传染的生命危险，奋不顾身地和吴会长他们这些爱心义工们一起为会员们服务，这是一种什么样的高尚情操啊！这又是一个多么令人敬仰的家庭啊！我也为人家长，心里一直担心着自己的孩子们，天天祈祷着他们平平安安；我也是会员，天天想着怎样居家少出，杜绝被传染的可能性。看到施兄弟一家的义举，我真的是觉得自己太渺小了。什么是爱心？什么是善良？什么是力量？施家三兄弟就是最好的答案！感恩你们三个年轻人！我们为你们骄傲！我们为你们祝福！在此也特别感谢所有一大早就站在泞泥的草地上为会员们分发口罩的爱心义工们！有你们同在，我们才安好！

《一个中国飞行员的故事》by 纽约橙郡中文学校 十年级学生 王安迪 Andy Wang

我一直觉得做一名飞行员，是一个特别神奇，特别有意义的职业，我也特别想学到更多的航空知识。昨天二月二十九号星期六上午，中国高级飞行员，机长 Eugene Peng 应邀来到了我们橙郡中文学校，给我们全体学生和老师们做了一场非常精彩的演讲！我非常喜欢彭叔叔的演讲，也从他那里学到了好多的航空知识。

彭叔叔告诉我们在人类文明进步的历史过程中，看到了小鸟在天空飞翔，就幻想着自己也会飞上天空，所以历史上很多人都尝试去设计制作了许多种不同的飞行器，但是它们都没有真正成功地飞到天上去。意大利著名画家达芬奇也曾经画了好几张飞行器的画。1903 年，莱特兄弟两个人通过不断的学习研究和实验，实现了人类历史上真正意义的飞行活动，从此以后人类不断地实验，

成功地制作了更多和更好的飞机。

您可能会问这样一个问题：飞机是怎样飞上天空的呢？彭叔叔告诉我们：飞机之所以会飞起来，是因为飞机的机翼产生了升力。飞机机翼上有低气压，飞机机翼下有高气压。飞机向前移动时，机翼会产生升力，将其向上推。飞机翼上的喷气发动机产生推力时，飞机将向前移动。飞机的方向舵和副翼会让它旋转或滚动，升降舵可以改变飞机的爬升或是下降。

那么您怎样才能成为一名合格的飞行员呢？彭叔叔举出了几个例子。您可以去飞行学校学习，也可以去参军。机长 Eugene Peng 叔叔是去的飞行学校，他毕业后成为一个职业飞行员，飞行过了各种各样不同机型的飞机。现在，他是一个私人企业航空公司的飞行机长。彭机长告诉我们，他还是在很小时候，

就梦想成为一名飞行员，在学习成长的过程中，始终没有放弃过这个梦想，并且为之不断的努力，最终实现了他儿时的梦想！做为一名机长，彭先生掌握了扎实的飞行技术和知识。他刻苦地学习航天知识，勤奋地提高飞行技能，现在，他不仅实现了他的小时候立下的目标，还在帮助那些有着航空兴趣的年轻人去实现他们的梦想。彭机长最喜欢的飞行部分是环游世界，可以接触不同地域的文化，领略世界不同的风光，他热爱他的航空事业。

彭机长的演讲受到了大家的欢迎，我也学到了很多航空知识。通过彭机长的成长故事，我明白了一个重要的生活道理：一个人只要有梦想，而且努力地为了自己的梦想而奋斗，永远不放弃，那么他就一定会成功的。

A Story of an Amazing Chinese Pilot

This past Saturday, our Chinese school was lucky enough to experience a presentation with the amazing Captain Eugene Peng. Personally, aviation seems like a very mysterious field to me. To begin his presentation, Captain Peng went over the history of planes by showing us pictures of the first sketches of planes and an actual picture of the first plane. Then, he showed us pictures of planes meant for civil aviation use and what future planes may look like. He also went over the various parts of a plane and what they do. In addition, he told us that to become a pilot, you must go through specific aviation education, but from there are many things you can do within the aviation field.

You can become an airline pilot, an instructor at flight school, or even join the military. He also shared the story of Captain Sully, which emphasized the life-changing choices that pilots have to make for the safety of their passengers.

After his main presentation, the OCCS Student Government was able to sit down with Captain Peng and interview him. We learned that he wanted to be a pilot at a very young age and that his favorite part of being a pilot is that he can travel around the world and interact with the different people and cultures. While he mentioned during the presentation that it can take up to seven years to become a pilot, he very proudly said that it

only took him five years to reach the esteemed status. When he worked as a pilot for a commercial airline, he flew about four times a week, but now that he works for a private jet company, he flies as often as his clients want him to.

One of the most impactful statements that Captain Peng made was actually not directly related to aircraft. He told us to never give up on our dreams and to work hard always. The future is only what we make of it. We are so glad that we had the opportunity to speak to Captain Eugene Peng, and we will forever be grateful for the things he taught us.

Pilot: A “Mysterious Job”

On February 29, 2020 (Leap day), Orange County Chinese School had the pleasure of having Captain Eugene Peng give OCCA students and staff a presentation on his incredible occupation. Captain Eugene Peng had the dream of becoming a pilot at the very young age of 7 and since then, he had never given up on it. He worked hard to attend a flight school in China and became captain in a span of only five years when on average it takes 5-7. He is currently an instructor, examiner and captain. Captain Peng went on to give some inside information on the job of a pilot. He walked us through history, describing how one of the first ideas of flying came from the famous artist and inventor Da Vinci. Later, the Wright brothers brought aviation to life by creating the very first airplane. Now we have airplanes in different situations such as civil service and military. (Captain Peng worked on major airlines but is now currently working at private companies). He then discussed the four bars on a pilot's jacket. The first symbolizes skill, the second symbolizes knowledge, the third symbolizes experience and the fourth symbolizes responsibility. To achieve the fourth and last is not at all simple. In fact, to become a captain is not simply about how skilled a person is at flying, but rather based on an individual's character. Captain Eugene ended the interview with these words of advice for young people who may or may not want to pursue a career in aviation: "If you want to become a pilot or whatever major you want, you have to work hard and be determined to achieve your goal. You will experience some obstacles but if you work hard and put time and effort in, you will get there".

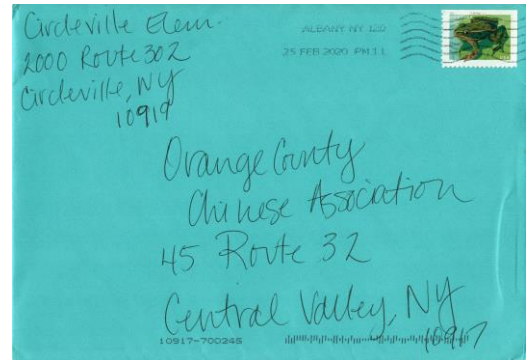
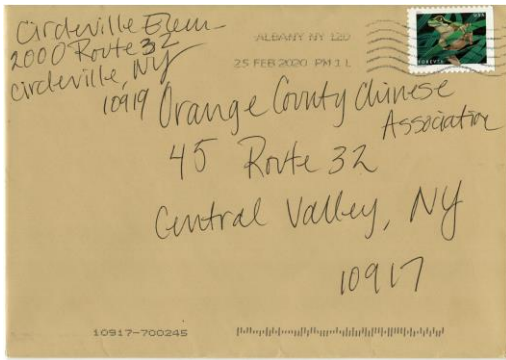

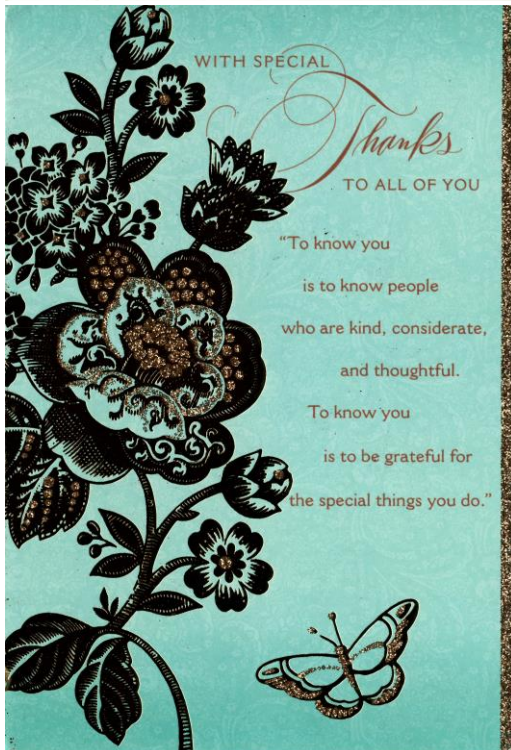
